We tried a new screening/triage method and *for the first time ever, not a single patient was turned away!*

We saw 762 patients, dispensed 250 eye glasses and performed 51 eye surgeries. Virtually all of the glaucoma medications were dispensed to treat each patient seen for glaucoma for one year each. PRAISE GOD!

The work team completed many projects, including plumbing and bathrooms in the lowa house, painting and concrete to Meredith school and various other painting and fix up projects on the hospital compound. And a patient-education mural was painted in the eye clinic to show the importance of using eye medications as directed.

Part of the group was able to travel by Cessna to Jacmel and tour a hospital and mission station and spend the night.

We got to share a worship and communion service with our Haitian brothers and sisters in the Bohoc area and go out with their prayer team to pray with a widow in their congregation...what a blessing.

As a team, we laughed together, prayed together, cried together, worked together....we were BLESSED together.
